Application of Hardin County Water District No. 1 to Adjust its Rates for Sewer Service

Pursuant to the Commission Staff's March 4, 2014 notice, a telephonic informal conference was held on March 4, 2014. Commission Staff requested the informal conference to discuss the tariff language included with the stipulation and recommendation. A list of the attendees is attached hereto. Jennifer Hans with the Attorney General's office, an intervenor in this case, received notice of the hearing. Via electronic mail, Ms. Hans notified Commission Staff and David Wilson, attorney for Hardin County Water District, that she was ill, but that the informal conference could proceed. A copy of the message is attached.

Commission Staff advised that questions regarding the Veolia contract may be asked at the scheduled hearing and recommended that personnel from Veolia be present at the hearing.

Commission Staff stated that the tariff sheets attached to the stipulation and recommendation contain language that likely would not be approved. Commission Staff recommended that the tariff sheets not be included with the stipulation and recommendation. If the Commission issues an order approving the stipulation and recommendation, the order will direct the utility to submit new tariff sheets reflecting the new rates. Commission Staff further recommended that at the conclusion of this rate case, the utility file a whole new tariff and work with the tariff branch.

There being no further discussions, the informal conference was adjourned.
