## **Interim Option Comment Guidelines** **Thursday, August 16, 2007**

The Commission will accept written comments from stakeholders until 5:00 PM Eastern Daylight Time on Wednesday, August 22<sup>nd</sup>. All comments should clearly identify the person/entity submitting the comment by: name; mailing address; phone number; fax number; and email address. The subject line for comments should state "Surcharge Interim Options". While the Commission will accept any information you wish to offer, the following points may help focus your comments. All comments will be posted on the Commission's website.

### **For All Stakeholders:**

- For each of the three interim options, an expression of support or opposition and a brief explanation of your position.
- For each of the three interim options, a discussion of the likely rate impacts.

### **For Jurisdictional Utilities:**

- List of all current surcharges/surcredits implicated by the Opinion and Order and the date(s) and Commission case(s) in which they were approved.
- Statement as to the total dollar amount of annual revenue derived from current surcharge methodologies.
- Statement as to the percentage of annual revenue currently derived from current surcharge methodologies.
- For each of the three interim options, estimated cost of compliance if costs can only be adjusted by the general rate case methodology.
- For each of the three interim options, any potential credit market impacts.
- For each of the three interim options, any potential corporate securities implications.
- For each of the three interim options, any potential operational implications.
