O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that Kentucky Utilities Company ("KU") shall file the original and 12 copies of the following information with the Commission, with a copy to all parties of record, within 14 days from the date of this Order. If the information cannot be provided by this date, KU should submit a motion for an extension of time stating the reason a delay is necessary and include a date by which it will be furnished. Such motion will be considered by the Commission. KU shall furnish with each response the name of the witness who will be available at the public hearing for responding to questions concerning each item of information requested.

1. Estimate the total annual revenue KU will receive from Phoenix Housing Corporation ("Phoenix Housing") if the housing facility is master metered. Estimate the total annual revenue KU

will receive if the facility is individually metered. Show all calculations. List all assumptions made in arriving at your response.

2. Estimate the total annual operating cost to KU to provide electric service to Phoenix Housing through individual meters.

3. Estimate the total annual operating cost to KU to provide electric service to Phoenix Housing through a master meter.

4. Provide an estimate of cost to KU to convert from a master meter to individual meters assuming the master meter has been in place and fully operational and construction is complete.

5. Provide a list of names and addresses of similar handicapped housing facilities currently being served by KU.

6. Indicate the date that KU, per the Kentucky Administrative Regulations, was prohibited from placing master meters in apartment complexes.

7. Explain the billing procedure which would be used if a master meter is installed at the proposed facility.

8. Explain the billing procedure which would be used if individual meters are installed at the proposed facility.


9. Explain the billing procedure which would be used if an individual or entity were to indicate to KU that he is to be solely responsible for payment for service provided to individuals at multiple residences other than his own.
