O R D E R

On April 1, 1992, Touch 1 Long Distance, Inc. ("Touch 1") filed an application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity and its proposed tariff for intrastate resold telecommunications services. In a letter accompanying its application, Touch 1 advised the Commission that its tariff would become effective upon 30 days notice to the public.


In accordance with 807 KAR 5:011 no tariff shall become effective except upon notice to the public and the Commission. This regulation also requires that tariffs filed with the Commission contain a date of issue and a date upon which the tariff is to become effective. Further, no tariff may become effective until authority to provide service has been granted through a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Touch 1's April 1, 1992 letter advising the Commission of the effective date of its tariff does not constitute adequate notice to the public and the Commission and the tariff will not become effective 30 days from that date.


