O R D E R

On September 15, 1992, Cincinnati Bell Long Distance, Inc. ("CBLD") filed a tariff wherein it proposed to offer a new service called Travel Link which allows subscribers to access CBLD via 950 access or via an 800 number. CBLD proposed that the filing become effective on and after October 15, 1992.

The Commission finds that, pursuant to KRS 268.190, further proceedings are necessary in order to determine the reasonableness of the proposed tariff filing.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:


1. The proposed tariff be and is hereby suspended for five months from October 15, 1992 up to and including March 14, 1993.
2. Nothing contained herein shall prevent the Commission from entering a final decision in this matter prior to the termination of the suspension period.
