1. METER READING

IT WAS RECOGNIZED EARLY IN THE RURAL ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE MOVEMENT THAT IN ORDER TO SUPPLY ELECTRIC SERVICE TO THE SPARSELY POPULATED RURAL AREAS THAT THE SELF-READING OF METERS BY MEMBER CONSUMERS WOULD BE A MAJOR CONTRIBUTING FACTOR TOWARDS SUPPLYING SUCH SERVICE AT THE LOWEST POSSIBLE RATES. THEREFORE, THE METER READING RULES OF THE OWEN COUNTY RURAL ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE CORPORATION ARE AS FOLLOWS:

- (a) CONSUMER WILL MARK THE READING ON THE COMBINATION BILL AND METER READING CARD WHICH HE RECEIVES ON OR ABOUT THE 10th OF EACH MONTH. THE CONSUMER WILL MAIL THE CARD, ALONG WITH THEIR PAYMENT, BY THE 15th OF EACH MONTH.
- (b) IF A CONSUMER'S METER READING CARD FAILS TO REACH THE COOPERATIVE'S OFFICE ON OR BEFORE THE 20th DAY OF THE MONTH, FOR THREE CONSECUTIVE MONTHS, THE COOPERATIVE SHALL READ THE CONSUMER'S METER ON THE FOURTH METER READING DATE AND MAKE A CHARGE OF \$2.25 FOR THIS SERVICE.

BILLING, ACCOUNTING AND COLLECTING PROCEDURE

The Cooperative's monthly billing period is from the 12th of one month to the 12th of the next month.

On or about the 7th or 8th of each month, the Cooperative renders an electric service statement to each consumer billed monthly for service to the 12th day of the previous month.

The consumer shall pay the net amount of the electric service statement by the 15th day of the month.

The second notice will be mailed to our delinquent accounts on or about the 25th of the month. Although our minimum bill is \$3.45 per month, the account will have to exceed ten dollars (\$10.00) before it will be classified as a delinquent account.

If not paid by the 30th of the month, it will be turned over to our service department for collection and when our service department is required to make a call to the member's premises for the purpose of collecting the delinquent bill, there will be a \$3.25 collection fee added, as stated in the second notice.

In the event a member is disconnected for the nonpayment of a bill and they request to be reconnected after regular working hours, which costs the Cooperative overtime, there will be a special charge in the amount of ten dollars (\$10.00) in addition to the \$3.25 service charge for making the first trip.

- (a) THE COOPERATIVE WILL MAKE ONLY ONE CONNECT WITHOUT CHARGE FOR ONE ACCOUNT. (NEW HOMES ONLY)
- (b) AFTER THE ORIGINAL "NO CHARGE" CONNECT IS MADE, ALL SUBSEQUENT RECONNECTS (REGARDLESS OF THE NAME OF THE OCCUPANT) OF ANY ACCOUNT SHALL CARRY A \$5.00 RECONNECTION CHARGE.
- (c) ANY APPLICANT REQUESTING A CONNECTION OF SERVICE OF AN ACCOUNT PREVIOUSLY OCCUPIED BY THE APPLICANT OR SOMEONE ELSE, SHALL BE ADVISED AT THE TIME OF HIS REQUEST THAT HE MUST PAY THE FIVE DOLLARS (\$5.00) RECONNECTION CHARGE.
- (d) IF THE APPLICANT MAKES THE ABOVE REQUEST IN PERSON TO THE OFFICE OR TO A SERVICEMAN, THE EMPLOYEE MUST COLLECT THE RECONNECTION CHARGE IMMEDIATELY.
- (e) IF THE RECONNECTION REQUEST IS MADE BY PHONE, THE APPLICANT SHOULD BE ADVISED TO BE AT THE ACCOUNT LOCATION AND PAY THE CHARGE WHEN THE MAINTENANCE MAN MAKES THE CONNECT OR TO COME TO THE OFFICE AND PAY THE RECONNECTION CHARGE.
- (f) IF THE REQUEST IS MADE BY MAIL, THE APPLICANT MUST BE ADVISED BY MAIL, IMMEDIATELY, THAT THE RECONNECTION CHARGE WILL BE COLLECTED BY THE SERVICEMAN WHEN THE RECONNECTION IS MADE OR THAT HE MAY COME TO THE OFFICE AND PAY THIS CHARGE. (FORM LETTER TO BE MADE FOR THIS.)

H. Minimum Charge

The minimum monthly charge shall be the highest one of the following charges: (a) the minimum monthly charge as specified in the contract for service (b) A charge of \$.75 per KVA per month of contract capacity.

I. Special Provisions

Delivery Point: If service is furnished at secondary voltage, the delivery point shall be the metering point unless otherwise specified in contract for service. All wiring, pole lines and other electric equipment on the load side of the delivery point shall be owned and maintained by the consumer. If service is furnished at sellers' primary line voltage, the delivery point shall be the point of attachment of sellers' primary line to consumer's transformer structure, unless otherwise specified in the contract for service. All wiring, pole lines and other electric equipment (except metering equipment) on the load side of the delivery point shall be owned and maintained by the consumer.

J. Terms of Payment

The above rates are net, the gross being 10 percent higher. In the event the current monthly bill is not paid by the 20th of the month, the gross charges shall apply.

* The monthly kilowatt hour usage shall be subject to plus or minus an adjustment per KWH determined in accordance with the "Fuel Adjustment Clause".
