The Cooperative shall maintain the lighting equipment including the lamp replacement, at no additional cost to the consumer within a reasonable time after the consumer notifies the Cooperative for the need of maintenance, except that in case of lamp or fixture damage because of vandalism, replacement may be made only once at no cost to the consumer. After that, the consumer may be required to pay for the cost of the replacemnt.

30. UNDERGROUND EXTENSIONS (Residential Subdivision)

- 6. an overhead service line to the applicant's meter base, whichever is greater and only the difference after giving such credit will be required as a deposit. Service lines to house (provided by developer) shall be installed and ready for inspection at the same time as the residence. Trench is to be left open until inspection has been made. If the Cooperative provides secondary service lines, applicant shall pay the "estimated average cost differential" between overhead and underground service.
