

The minimum monthly charge under the above rate shall be \$3.00 net where 10 KVA or less of transformer capacity is required. Each consumer who requires more than 10 KVA of transformer capacity shall pay, in addition to the above minimum, \$.75 for each additional KVA or fraction thereof required. Payment of the minimum monthly charge shall entitle the member in all cases to the use of the number of kilowatt-hours corresponding to the minimum charge in accordance with the foregoing rate.

The minimum monthly charge to churches under the above rate shall be \$1.50 net for 25 KWH where 10 KVA or less of transformer capacity is required. Each church which requires more than 10 KVA of transformer capacity



MINIMUM ANNUAL CHARGE FOR SEASONAL SERVICE:

Consumers requiring service only during certain seasons not exceeding 9 months per year may guarantee a minimum annual charge, in which case there shall be no minimum monthly charge. The minimum annual charge shall be sufficient to assure adequate compensation for the facilities installed to serve the consumer, and in no event shall it be less than \$9.00 per KVA of installed transformer capacity or \$300.00 whichever is greater.

SERVICE PROVISIONS:

1. Delivery Point. If the service is furnished at secondary voltage, the delivery point shall be the metering point, unless otherwise specified in the contract for service. All wiring, pole lines and other electric equipment on the load side of the delivery point shall be owned and maintained by the Consumer.

If the service is furnished at Seller's primary line voltage, the delivery point shall be the point of attachment of Seller's primary line to Consumer's transformer structure unless otherwise specified in the contract for service. All wiring, pole lines and other electric equipment (except metering equipment) on the load side of the delivery point shall be owned and maintained by the Consumer.

2. Primary Service. If service is furnished at primary distribution voltage, a discount of fifteen cents (\$.15) per KW shall apply to the demand charge, and if the minimum charge is based on transformer capacity, a discount of seven per cent (7%) shall apply to the minimum charge. However, the Seller shall have the option of metering at secondary voltage and adding the estimated transformer losses to the metered kilowatt demand and kilowatt hours.

TERMS OF PAYMENT

The above rates are net, the gross rates being 5% higher. In the event the current monthly bill is not paid by the fifteenth of the month following the meter reading date, the gross rates shall apply.

It shall be optional with the consumer whether the service will be billed under this schedule or any other schedule applicable to this load.

TYPE OF SERVICE

Three-phase, 60 cycles, at Seller's standard voltages.

RATE

- First 100 KWH per month @ 5.0¢ per KWH
- Next 200 KWH per month @ 4.0¢ per KWH
- Next 700 KWH per month @ 3.0¢ per KWH
- Over 1,000 KWH per month @ 2.5¢ per KWH

POWER FACTOR ADJUSTMENT

The consumer agrees to maintain unity power factor as nearly as practicable. Billings under the above rate will be adjusted for consumers with 100 KVA more of required transformer capacity to correct for average power factors lower than 85%, and may be so adjusted for other consumers if and when the Seller deems necessary. Such adjustments will be made by increasing the monthly bill 1% for each 1% which the average power factor is less than 85% lagging.

FUEL COST ADJUSTMENT CHARGE

In case the rate under which Seller purchases power at wholesale is adjusted in accordance with a fuel cost adjustment provision in Seller's wholesale power contract, the foregoing energy charges shall be adjusted each month by the same amount per KWH as the fuel cost adjustment per KWH in Seller's wholesale power bill for the next preceding month.

3. Primary Service. 


