



THE RULES AND REGULATIONS INCLUDED IN THE TARIFF OF BRACKEN COUNTY WATER DISTRICT ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE BY THE BRACKEN COUNTY WATER DISTRICT'S COMMISSIONER'S AT ANY TIME. CHANGES MAY BE SUBJECT TO APPROVAL BY THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION.

Service line shall be at least twenty four (24) inches in depth. The first six (6) inches of backfill shall be minus or rock.

A cut off valve shall be installed for customer's use in case of a leak in customer's line. This cut off shall be located behind the meter on the customer's side.

A check valve or an approved backflow prevention device shall be installed to prevent backflow. This will prevent water heater element from burning out in case of a leak or shut off on the District's line.

Copper or brass fittings shall be used when connecting to the meter or valve.

LEAK ADJUSTMENT POLICY

The following leak adjustment may be made for Bracken Co. Water District customers who request same.

A. One (1) adjustment in a twelve (12) month period may be allowed upon proof of leak and proof of correction of such problem, i.e. meter reading verification, plumbing receipt and/or material for customer repair.

B. Twelve (12) months previous consumption average shall be paid by customer per District's current rate schedule( if this history of usage is not available the Water District's average for the previous calendar year shall apply).

C. The leak amount (amount exceeding their average) shall be charged the rate the District pays it's supplier plus pumping and distribution charges.

Example Only: Total usage 10,000 gallons.	12 mo. avg. 4,000
2,000 minimum bill 8.54 (water rate only)	
2,000 above min. 6.14 (3.07/1000)	
6,000 leak 10.44 (6,000 X 1.74*/1000)	
Total bill \$25.12

Bracken County Water District shall issue adjustments to a customer's bill only in order to fulfill the Public Service Commission regulations. For example, 807 KAR 5:006 Section 10 specifies the conditions under which a customer's bill may be adjusted as a result of a meter test.

However, in an effort to be fair to all customers, as of the effective date of this tariff, Bracken County Water District will no longer issue credits for leaks within the water system on the customer's side of the meter.

Adjustments will be issued for water used for flushing brown water if the customer's bill for the period in which the flushing occurred was greater than the customer's average bill on a case by case basis where the presence of brown water is documented and the amount of water flushed is within reason.

THE RULES AND REGULATIONS INCLUDED IN THE TARIFF OF BRACKEN COUNTY WATER DISTRICT ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE BY THE BRACKEN COUNTY WATER DISTRICT'S COMMISSIONERS AT ANY TIME. CHANGES *SHALL* BE SUBJECT TO APPROVAL BY THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION.

All service lines beyond the metering point should be installed of material consisting of copper or PVC pipe with a rating of not less than 160m psi. The size of the service line beyond the point of delivery should not be less than 3/4"; However, a larger size may be needed to provide adequate service. If the customer's point of use is at a higher elevation than the point of delivery, the customer should consult with a reputable engineering firm to size the service line from the point of delivery. Piping on the premises of the customer must be so installed that connections are conveniently located with respect to the District lines and mains. The customer shall provide a place for metering which is unobstructed and accessible at all times.

Should a prospective customer request service at a point of delivery now, or in the future, does not meet his/her personal requirements, he/she may make provision for an individual pressure booster system. The manner of connection, location, cross-connection, protection and type is subject to approval of the District. The District reserves the right to require discontinuance and disconnection should the private booster system have a detrimental effect on the District's system.

In the installation of a service line, the customer shall install a shut off device and leave the trench open and pipe uncovered until it is inspected by the District and is shown to be free from irregularity or other defects.
