SPECIAL NON-RECURRING CHARGES:

1. Reconnection Charge: \$50.00

Will be assessed to reconnect service that has been terminated for non-payment of service or for violation of utility or PSC rules and regulations.

2. Late Payment Penalty: 10%

Will be assessed if a customer fails to pay a bill for services by the due date shown on the customer's bill. The penalty may be assessed only once on any bill for rendered services. Any payment received shall first be applied to the bill for service rendered. Additional penalty charges shall not be assessed on unpaid penalty charges.

3. Service Line Inspection Charge: \$25.00

Will be assessed to inspect a customer's service line from the point of delivery at the meter to the point of usage. The service line inspection charge will be waived if confirmation is provided by the customer from the Kentucky State Plumbing Inspector that a state plumbing permit has been obtained and the Kentucky State Plumbing Inspector will inspect the service line.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Meters will be read monthly on the 20th of each month.
2. Bills will be dated and mailed on the first of each month. Said bills will state that they are to be paid within ten days. If not paid by the 10th of the following month, water service will be discontinued in accordance with 807 KAR 5:006(14).
3. All meters will be located on district mains and in the absence of special permission on the property to be served.
4. Complaints may be made to the operator of the system and may be appealed to the District Commission.
5. The principal place of business of the District will be the residence of W.D. Juett, Route #6, Frankfort, Kentucky 40601.
6. Water bills may be mailed to Elkhorn Water District, P.O. Box 67, Frankfort, Kentucky 40601, or paid at No. 5 above.
7. If water service is discontinued because of failure to pay the water bill, a \$15.00 charge will be required before service is reinstated.
8. A \$5.00 deposit will be required if a customer requests an accuracy check of his meter. If his meter checks accurate, he forfeits his \$5.00 deposit to pay for the checking of his meter. If his meter tests inaccurate, then his \$5.00 deposit is refunded and the District installs him a new meter at no cost to him.
9. A deposit of \$20.00 may be charged a new applicant requesting service.
10. Interest will be paid or credited each customer who has a deposit at the rate actually earned. If the customer moves in the middle of the year the customer will be paid on a pro-rated basis.

11. Meter Correction Rule - Unless the total lost or gained exceeds \$20.00 the customer will not be billed or refunded and the amount will be absorbed by Elkhorn Water District

Correction, repair or replacement of the water meter will be made regardless of the amount gained or lost.

In the event the monetary adjustment exceeds \$20.00 807KAR5.006 applies.

12. Before a new customer is permitted to connect to the water system an inspection fee must be paid to the District. The District shall inspect the new service in accordance to the following criterion:

I. Service line shall be a minimum of 30" deep and shall be Class 200 pipe or better, no smaller than 3/4".

II. The structure shall have no cross connections to another water source.

III. The service line shall not be backfilled until approval has been made by the District. The service line shall not contain any tee or branch connection to another structure. The backfill shall be material free from rock and rubble and the line shall not contain rock in the trench.

IV. Each structure shall have a cut-off valve at the point it enters the structure. The valve shall be the same size as the service line to which it is attached.

FIRE DEPARTMENTS:

Any city, county, urban-county, charter county, fire protection district, or volunteer fire protection district ("User") may withdraw water from the utility's water distribution system for the purpose of fighting fires or training firefighters at no charge on the condition that it maintains estimates of the amount of water used for fire protection and training during the calendar month and reports the amount of this water usage to the utility no later than the 15th day of the following calendar month.

Any city, county, urban-county, charter county, fire protection district, or volunteer fire protection district that withdraws water from the utility's water distribution system for fire protection or training purposes and fails to submit the required report on water usage in a timely manner shall be assessed the cost of this water.

A non-reporting user's usage shall be presumed to 0.3 percent of the utility's total water sales for the calendar month. A non-reporting user may present evidence of its actual usage to rebut the presumed usage. The utility shall consider this evidence and may adjust the presumed usage amount accordingly.

The non-reporting user shall be billed for this usage at the lowest usage block rate regardless of customer classification that the utility charges.

A non-reporting user shall also be assessed a penalty of \$ 25.00 for each failure to submit a report in a timely manner.



RULES FOR NEW CONSTRUCTION OF SUBDIVISIONS


All subdivision plans will follow the below rules to be approved by the Board for water service:

1. All plans for a subdivision must be presented to the board of Elkhorn Water District at least 60 days in advance of any decision to be rendered by the board.
2. All line plans must be reviewed and approved by Sanitary Engineering before any construction may be started.
3. All subdivisions must come off a 6 inch main line or larger.
4. The lines inside the subdivision are to be 4 inch lines or larger.
5. All pipe must be 200 PSI PVC 20 foot slip joint pipe.
6. All lines must be circled with 2 outlets off the 6 inch main line.
7. All lines are to be layed no closer than 4 feet to the edge of the black top road surface, and no further than 15 feet away from the black top road surface.
8. There are to be no other utilities such as telephone, electric, or sewer lines layed in the same ditch as the main line. The ditches for them are to be kept 4 feet away from the pipe line ditch itself.
9. All lines are to have at least 30 inches of cover. The inspector may have the builder go deeper to allow for grading of the land at a later time.
10. All lines are to be layed with no rock within 8 inches around the lines. If there is not sufficient dirt for padding, the inspector may require densograte or glass-eyed sand to be put around the lines as padding at the builders expense. Dirt must be rounded to a height of 6 inches on top of the lines for settling.
11. All parts and materials used in the construction of subdivision lines must be new.
12. There must be a valve at both outlets into the subdivision; there must be a valve at the beginning of each street and a valve at the end of each street, if the streets are 2,000 feet or longer there must be a valve every 1,000 feet.
13. The water district may require flush hydrants which are to be used to keep sanitary conditions inside the subdivision. The flush hydrants will be placed on the property line and will have a gate valve placed between the hydrant and the main line. There is to be nothing placed in front of or around the hydrant which may make it difficult to maintain or get to. Any fire hydrants that are placed in subdivisions will also follow the same installation rules as flush hydrants.
14. There will be no fittings used with an acute angle of more than 45 degrees.



15. All t's, 45's, fire hydrants and valves are to be concrete and rodding when layed.
16. All meters will be set in the front yards of the unit they serve.
17. All pipes crossing underneath a black top road surface must be cased in iron pipe. This pipe must extend 3 feet out from under the road on each side.
18. Air valves may be required if the inspector or board feels that they are necessary.
19. No lines are to be layed or covered without the inspector being present, if this happens the inspector may require that the lines be uncovered at the builder's expense.
20. Once the lines are layed they are to be flushed and pressure tested for leaks then chlorinated to 50 PPM and at the end of 24 hours they must have 25 PPM free chlorin, then the lines may be put into service.
21. After subdivision plans have been approved by the board there can be no changes or additions to these plans without the consent of the board.
22. The builder is responsible for line maintenance for one year. At the end of one year, the lines will be maintained by the district.
23. Though the lines are put in by the builder, no one will be allowed to put in meters on the lines except the water district. All tap fees are to be payed before the meter is set.
24. Anything that may come up in the building of the subdivision that is not covered in the above regulations will be covered in the publication known as Water Systems and Sewage Systems Specifications of the Bowling Green Municipal Utility Board.

The above regulation for extending water to subdivisions were adopted at a meeting of the Elkhorn Water District August 5, 1980. W. D. Juett moved to adopt, seconded by George W. Switzer. All three commissioners voted yes on a roll call vote.

APPLICATION FOR WATER SERVICE

The undersigned (hereinafter called the Applicant) hereby applies for water service and agrees to purchase water from Elkhorn Water District (hereinafter called the District) upon the following terms and conditions:

1. The Applicant will, when water becomes available, purchase from the District all water used on the premises described below and will pay thereafter monthly rates approved by the Public Service Commission. All customers shall pay at least the monthly minimum service charge approved by the Public Service Commission even if no water is used during the month. The bill is due on the 15th of each month and after the 15th of the month a 10% late payment charge will be added. On or after the 25th of the month SERVICE WILL BE DISCONTINUED. Discontinuance of service due to non-payment of a bill will be carried out in accordance with Public Service Commission regulations, which require that customers receive at least 5 days' written notice of the District's intent to discontinue service and that service not be discontinued before twenty (20) days after the mailing date of the original unpaid bill. There is a \$_____ fee to have water reinstated.
2. The Applicant will comply with and be bound by the rates, rules, and regulations for furnishing water service contained in the District's tariff approved by the Public Service Commission.
3. The undersigned will grant to the District, at its request, the necessary rights, privileges and easements to construct, operate, replace, repair and perpetually maintain on the property owned and occupied by the undersigned, its lines or lines for transmission and distribution of water, and will execute and deliver to the District any conveyance, grant or instrument which the District shall deem necessary or convenient for said purpose, or any of them. All distribution lines supplying the undersigned with water and all meters and other equipment constructed and installed by the District on said property, except the service line shall be paid for by the undersigned, shall at all times be the sole property of the District and the District shall have the right to access said property for repair and service, and upon the discontinuance of service for any reason, to remove the same.
4. The Applicant will not permit anyone else to connect to the District's water line and meter, or the Applicant's service line, without prior written consent of the District.
5. The Applicant is responsible for cost of repairing all damage done to all meter tops (covers) regardless of who causes the damage (except by the District). The Applicant is cautioned that many meter tops are damaged by power lawn mowers and by being run over by vehicles.

The acceptance of this application by the District shall constitute a binding contract between the Applicant and the District and further consideration of said acceptance and the installation of facilities by the District to provide the Applicant with water. The Applicant agrees to take said water from the District so long as he occupies the premises described below.

LEAK ADJUSTMENTS

A leak adjustment can be figured once in a 12-month period. It can be for one month or two consecutive months, whichever is applicable. The adjustment will be figured based on average usage for the three (3) months prior to the leak.
